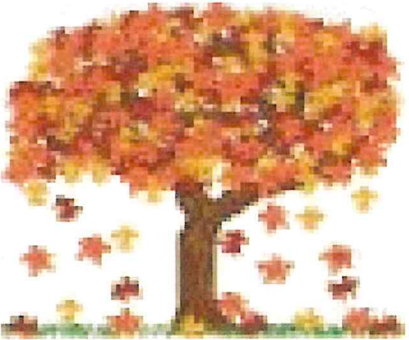
Monthly Meetings
